

PiR asks for 5 student names and emails. They will be in charge of spreading the survey among their peers and collecting enough data





# OUR STANDARD PROCEDURE

### School's representatives login

Access limited to:

- Student participation numbers
- Results from previous years (if existant)

#### **Student Media Pack**

Students will receive support, both technical and content related

The link MUST BE copy-pasted exactly as in the email and SAVED

### **Access granted to students**

- PIR sends unique links and logins to students
- Students will spread it among their peers and collect survey responses



### Deadline 31 March

Try to reach and go beyond at least 100 total survey responses (where relevant min. 50 undergrad, 50 grad, 20 MBA).
The more responses the better!!

### Provide input to add-on questions (max 2 weeks)

Try to reach and overcome at least 120 survey responses



### **AACSB-compatible**

Provide focal topic as defined for AACSB accreditation for the following pre-formulated questions (3 Likert, 1 open):

- To what extent has your School been effective in creating impact in its focal area through its culture and governance structures?
- To what extent has your School been effective in creating impact in its focal area through its educational programs, its learning methods, and its student support activities?
- To what extent has your School been effective in creating impact in its focal area through being a role model in its actions and its public engagement?
- What should your School do to improve its impact in its focal area

### **School specific**

Provide your focal topic and define up to four fully customizable questions:

- **Single Choice:** Pose a question with multiple pre-set answer options, but the student can only select one.
- **Multiple Choice:** Similar to Single Choice, but students can select multiple answers from the options provided.
- Open Ended: Here, you can ask an open question. Students will have a text field to enter their response. Click "Add new question" to save your open-ended question.
- Likert Scale: This question type allows students to express their level of agreement on a scale from 1 to 10. Schools can customize the descriptors (e.g., from "Very low" to "Very high" or other suitable alternatives) to better suit the question context.



## WE WILL PROVIDE SUPPORT DEFINING SCHOOLS' FOCAL AREA

### **AACSB Compatible Questions**

AACSB implemented a societal impact focus in its 2020 accreditation standards. Guiding Principle No. 2 spells out the association's vision that "business education is a force for good in society," while Standard 9 asks schools to demonstrate positive societal impact. For this they should choose a focal area to demonstrate their positive impact. Clearly, the focal area needs to be defined by each school individually to be used for their AACSB accreditation!

### **Examples**

- Ensuring that students comprehend environmental, social, and governance (ESG) issues
- Sustainable development, digitalization, and globalization
- Diversity, equity, and inclusion
- Building a fairer and more sustainable society
- Nurturing global citizens for a sustainable world
- Promoting responsible leadership in the community
- Engaging with the community through dedicated school programs







### **STOP**

- Waste on campus (energy, plastic, paper, food)
- Ignoring them
- Downplaying diversity and fairness
- Greenwashing and unethical partnerships with businesses
- Overloading them

### **START**

- Integrate sustainability broadly into the curriculum – and make it mandatory
- Address relevant practical problems and solutions
- Integrate stakeholders from business and society into the learning process
- Innovate the learning methods
- Make sure the teaching faculty is openminded and committed to the topic
